- Offers are too good to be true, e.g. promise of a high salary.
- Promotes pyramid selling / opportunity to set up of your own business that promise a large investment return provided with an initial upfront payments.
- Requires personal details, such as your bank account number or identification card or your driving license. These documents could later be used for identity theft.



TO PROTECT YOURSELF;

- Never fall or respond to offers that claiming to guarantee income or requiring you to pay certain fees before they can offer the job for you.
- Never disclose your personal details such as your bank account number or to agree to transfer money to someone else
- Do not provide your login password to any online platform to anyone.
