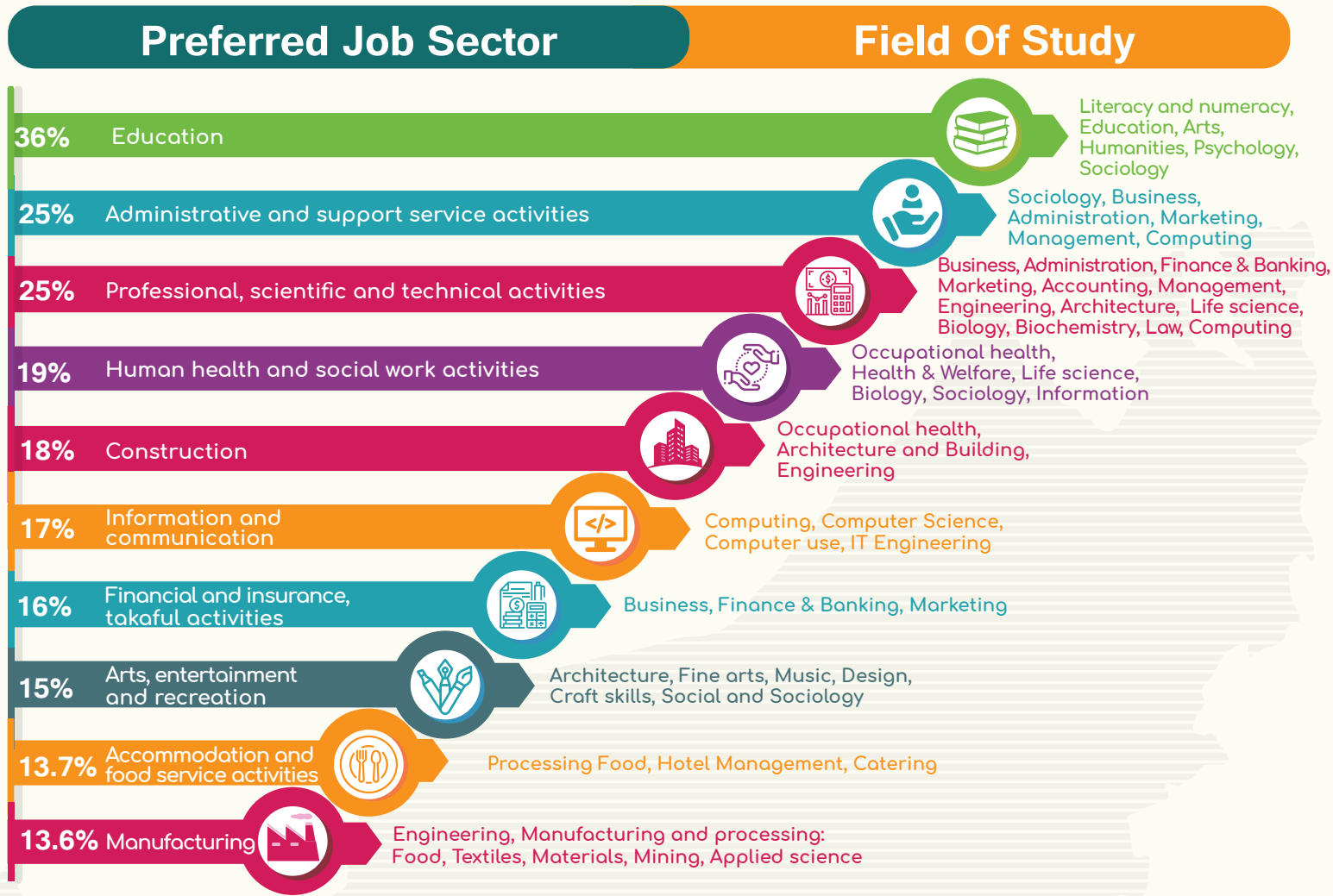




GRADUATES' CHOICE: WHERE TO AFTER GRADUATION?

# Graduates' Top 10 Job Sectors



The above graphic illustrates the **TOP 10 Job Sectors** preferred by graduates.

## FINDINGS & ANALYSIS:

Across 21 industries listed as per Malaysia Standard Industrial Classification 2008 (MSIC 2008), we present to you the list of Top 10 Job Sectors preferred by local graduates as per above. When comparing on graduates preference of the job sectors, we also examined on their relevance field of study. Most graduates want work opportunities in job sectors that are related to their education field of study; and only a minority of students choose a different job sector to what they had studied. Business & Administrative students (79%) say they prefer work opportunities in N - Administrative and support service activities, M - Professional, scientific and technical activities and K - Financial and insurance/takaful activities; and Engineering students (68%) prefer work opportunities in F - Construction and M - Professional, scientific and technical activities. To have a better idea of the salary range based on each job sector, we suggest graduates to refer to the Employee Report section. For instance, P – Education which is the most popular choice among graduates (36%), it has an average monthly salary (RM1573 – RM2561); followed by N - Administrative and support service activities (RM1392 – RM3089), and so forth. As well, we have also compared the graduates' preference in job sectors with relationship to their gender which can be found in the next page – see the difference between Male and Female preference towards job sectors they like to work in.
